Tips for composing effective posts:

- Have a clear and concise message.
- The best posts are a call to action. Turn your followers into advocates by giving them a clear action to take.
- When retweeting or reposting, add value to the post by adding your own commentary, or add a link to additional media on the topic.
- Use popular hashtags but use them in moderation. Using more than two hashtags can muddle your message.





• Add visuals to your post. A photo, a link with a thumbnail, or a video can generate significantly more attention.
