


## Vision

## Workplace Research:



knew at least one co-worker who experienced domestic violence

54%

of those facing domestic violence said it happened at/near work

of women reported experiencing some form of psychological, physical, or sexual violence by an intimate partner in their lifetimes.

44%

**82%** disclose to coworkers


